

## Scope of Practice

As per section 2(h) of the <u>Newfoundland and Labrador Regulations</u> under the <u>Health Professionals Act</u>, "medical laboratory technology" is defined as the performance of laboratory investigations on the human body or on specimens taken from the human body and the interpretation and evaluation of quality control data to verify the accuracy and precision of investigation results for use by health care practitioners in the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of disease.
